Wednesday, March 4



Sunday, March 8 Pueblo, CO

This morning we'll have a short drive to the Spanish town, Santa Fe, the capitol of the state of New Mexico. A multiplicity of cultures, Native American Indian, Spanish, Mexican and Anglo provide a rich and very colorful heritage. You will marvel at the Loretto Chapel, home of the miraculous staircase sometimes referred to as St. Joseph's Staircase. Puzzling architects and engineers, the mysterious staircase makes over two complete 360 degree turns, stands 20 feet tall, has no center support and rests solely on its base and against the choir loft. Our overnight accommodations will be at the LaQuinta in Pueblo, CO.



Monday, March 9 Kearney, NE
Skirting alongside the Colorado Rockies, we'll arrive in Colorado Springs and view the Garden of the Gods Park, a registered National Natural Landmark. Imagine dramatic views, 300' towering sandstone rock formations against a backdrop of snow-capped Pikes Peak and brilliant blue skies. This world-class Visitor & Nature Center and Museum is the most visited attraction in the region with all new interactive exhibits. A trained Colorado naturalist will "step-on" our coach to give a



tour of the park. Our afternoon travels will lead us into Nebraska for our overnight stay at the Country Inn & Suites in Kearney.

Tuesday, March 10 Home

This time of year over 600,000 Sandhill Cranes migrate to the Platte River Valley in order to 'fuel up' before resuming their northward migration. We will make a stop to learn more about the migration at the visitor center at the Rowe Sanctuary.
